13 Bid for hosting future 41 International AGM

SJ bought up two proposals. The first – Do we want to bid again for 41 Intl AGM?. The idea is all the background work would be done by Fellowship & IRO. We have much more control & would be better prepared. SJ proposes, PG seconds & vote is unanimous Second – Now that the first part is confirmed/agreed, do we want to go for a hosting bid in 2022?. NM – is there enough time, if we fail again is there a reputational risk? SJ – yes to both. SJ proposes, PG seconds, vote is for with 1 Ag & 1 Abs.

14 GDPR

GFS presents, there are v v many opinions on GDPR (most of them are wrong). We now have an electronic version of the return up and running. Most Councillors & Club Officers emails are out of date. We have 'gatekeepers' who are not forwarding on emails. If you are not on CAS, you are not covered (Insured) & you are not members. All forms that have been received, have been updated. GFS recommends that we email out to all members, not just the contacts/officers. Gives example of Southgate 41 Club where only 3 out of 12 members were correct according to CAS. Re-iterates the need to get everything up to date, if CAS works, it all works.

GS – 1) Members question why they need to re-confirm, when no other organisations seem to be doing this (we <u>have</u> to seek consent in order to market). 2) We need all the forms all in one place (Marchesi House?). 3) There is a lack of trust (not all members want to supply their details). GS asks for Council consent to email ALL members. Vote carried, with 2 Abs.





15 Presidential Car/New Affinity Deal

SJ puts up a slideshow from PSA Groupe. This is the company behind Peugeot, Citroen, DS. The deal provides maximum benefits to members for a lease scheme. They in turn will provide us with a Presidential car. SJ seeks agreement in principle to move forward on the deal. They have not asked for exclusivity and confirms this is a lease only scheme & doesn't affect the Hyundai purchase scheme.
